

FACTS	WHAT DOES TRANSAMERICA FINANCIAL ADVISORS, INC. ("TFA") DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?		
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social Security number and income ■ Account balances and account transactions ■ Assets and investment experience <p>When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>		
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons TFA chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	Transamerica Financial Advisors, Inc.
What we do	
How does TFA protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. TFA maintains physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect your nonpublic personal information.
How does TFA collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Open an account or enter into an investment advisory contract ■ Apply for insurance ■ Make deposits or withdrawals from your account or provide account information ■ Seek advice about your investments ■ Tell us about your investment or retirement portfolio We collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ■ affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ TFA does not share information among its affiliates for marketing purposes.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ TFA does not share information with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Our joint marketing partners include financial institutions and credit unions.

Other important information

This notice applies to individual consumers who are customers or former customers of TFA. This notice replaces all previous notices of our consumer privacy policy, and may be amended at any time. We will keep you informed of changes or amendments as required by law.

If you close your account and transfer your account to another firm, in the process of transferring your investments we may share your information with the new broker-dealer or custodian that you or your representative selects. Unless otherwise restricted by your representative's contract with TFA, if the representative servicing your account leaves us, the representative may be permitted to retain copies of your nonpublic personal information so that he or she can assist with the transfer of your account and continue to serve you at a new firm. When your representative associates with a new firm, the representative's continuing use of such information becomes subject to the new firm's privacy policy.

If your representative leaves our firm, or if you decide to close your TFA account and transfer to another firm with your representative, and you do not want us to share your nonpublic personal information (other than as permitted by law) with the representative or the new firm, you may contact us by calling: (727) 299-1476.

If your primary address is in a state that requires your affirmative consent to share your personal information with a new firm (such as Alaska, California, Maine, Massachusetts, North Dakota, or Vermont), then you must give your written consent before we will allow your representative to take any of your personal information to the new firm.

If any of your accounts with us have a Vermont mailing address, TFA will automatically treat those accounts as if you elected not to share information about your creditworthiness and not to receive marketing from our affiliates; we will also not obtain consumer credit reports about you without your consent. If any of your accounts with us have a California, North Dakota, or Vermont mailing address, TFA will automatically not include those accounts in any joint marketing activities with nonaffiliated financial companies.

NOTICE OF PRIVACY POLICY

Information Only – No Response Necessary

Protecting your privacy is very important to us. We want you to understand what information we collect and how we use it. We collect and use nonpublic personal information in order to provide our customers with a broad range of financial products and services. We treat your information with the utmost respect and in accordance with our Privacy Policy.

What Information We Collect and From Whom We Collect It

We may collect nonpublic personal information about you from the following sources:

- Information we receive from you on applications or other forms;
- Information about your transactions with us, our affiliates, or others; and
- Information we receive from non-affiliated third parties, including consumer reporting agencies and insurance support organizations.

Nonpublic personal information is nonpublic information about you that we obtain in connection with providing a financial product or service to you. In some states, personal information may also include your name, address and medical record information but not privileged information. This information may be collected in person, by mail, fax, or by other electronic means as permitted by law or as expressly authorized by you.

What Information We Disclose and To Whom We Disclose It

Depending upon the product or service offered, we may disclose nonpublic personal information we collect to:

- Persons or companies that perform services on our behalf.
- Other financial institutions with which we have joint marketing agreements as permitted by law. In Vermont this includes only your name, contact information, policy coverage and information about your transactions with us or our affiliates.
- A medical professional for the purpose of disclosing a medical problem of which you may not be aware.
- Other insurance support organizations for use in connection with an insurance transaction or to prevent fraud.
- An insurance regulatory authority.
- A law enforcement or other governmental authority to prevent or prosecute fraud or other unlawful activities.
- Organizations conducting actuarial research studies.
- If applicable, a group policyholder for reporting claims experience or conducting an audit.

We do not disclose any nonpublic personal information about you to either our affiliates or non-affiliates, except as permitted by law. Our affiliates are companies with which we share common ownership. They offer life and health insurance and pension and savings products. Nonpublic personal information about you that we obtain from a report prepared by an insurance support organization may be retained by that organization and disclosed to other persons.

Your Right to Verify Accuracy of Information We Collect

Keeping your information accurate and up to date is very important to us. In some states, you may have the right to write to us in order to request that you have reasonable access to your nonpublic personal information (this includes a record of any subsequent disclosures of medical record information). You may not access information relating to or in anticipation of a claim or a criminal or civil proceeding. If you believe the information we collected about you is inaccurate, you may request that we amend, correct or delete it. We will notify you of our decision, give you our reasons and the opportunity to file a concise statement of dispute with us if you do not agree. Your statement will be made a part of our file and sent to persons or organizations that received your information in the past and in the future as required by law.

Your Choice to Limit Marketing

You may limit our affiliates from marketing their products and services to you based on your personal information that we collect and share with them. This information may include the products you own and your account history. To limit marketing offers, contact us at (770) 246-9889.

Our Security Procedures

We restrict access to nonpublic personal information and only allow disclosures to persons and companies as permitted or required by law to assist in providing products or services to you. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect your nonpublic personal information. Should your relationship with us end, we will maintain and only disclose your nonpublic personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.
